KULTUREBREAK – DANCE NATION SCHOOLS SPECTACULAR

Charles Conder Primary School in partnership with Kulturebreak is offering our school students a wonderful opportunity to participate in the ACT Dance Nation Schools Spectacular. Dance Nation is a celebration of young people involving up to 500 students from across the ACT in a highly engaging program that empowers them to be their best. Last week during our Friday assembly we heard from the Kulturebreak founder Frances Owusu. We are very focused on delivering programs in schools that support the social inclusion and well-being of children. Research supports the statement that “happy children learn better” therefore we believe the Dance Nation program theme for this year “Transformers” will provide a positive experience that will enhance each child’s learning journey.

Kulture Break will deliver the specialist dance teaching program in Term 2 comprising of 16 workshops in total for students in Years 2 - 6. This will conclude with a special performance at the school showcase spectacular at the National Convention Centre on Thursday June 28th 6:30pm-9:00pm. The Project has been subsidised by Kulturebreak and will therefore be offered to students at \$150 which equates to \$9.50 per session including a shirt and bus transfers for rehearsals.

To achieve a successful outcome of the project we require a serious commitment from each student who will participate. As spaces are limited, the first 40 students with full payment will be offered a place. The program will run if we have 20 participants. Students who wish to participate must be able to commit to attend all scheduled school workshops organised at lunchtimes, and attend the final performance.

In your consideration to giving your child permission please carefully assess whether he/she is able and prepared to commit to the entire project. Each student must also have permission to be photographed and filmed as the project will be a filmed and photographed event.

The Dance Nation project will start in Term2 and conclude in week 8 Term 2. These classes will be conducted at 11.15am twice a week on Mondays and Wednesdays.
