Kindergarten Workshops

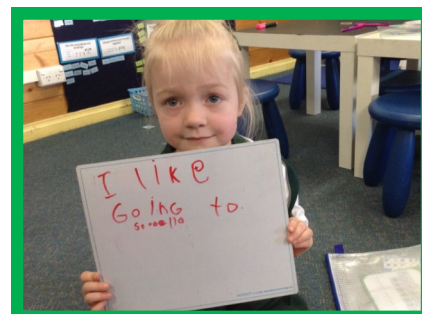
On Thursday we have our Literacy and Maths workshops. Students are grouped together with similar goals across the learning house where they may be learning in a different classroom with a different teacher. During these sessions, students engage in a variety of tasks that challenge, engage and progress their learning.

The focus in our Literacy workshops are:

- **Miss Bounds:** writing simple sentences and using the sounding out strategy
- **Ms Rezakhani:** identifying letters and sounds and early writing skills
- **Ms Kirkland:** creating a cohesive writing piece with developing detail

The focus in our Maths workshops are:

- **Miss Bounds:** Sequencing numbers to 20 and automatically identifying the number before and after
- **Ms Rezakhani:** Basic addition strategies using concrete materials and the counting on strategy
- **Ms Kirkland:** Identifying numbers to 20 and making collections for these numbers
- **Ms Thompson:** Identifying and sequencing numbers to 10
