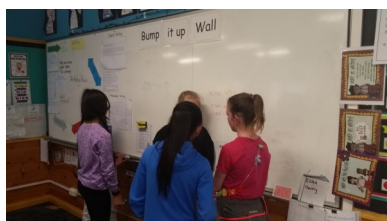
Year 6 Combined Band
