Late last term the school provided an opportunity for the parents as key stakeholders in the community to be surveyed on numerous areas and levels of satisfaction. Over the last four years as the school has grown, the school culture has strengthened and continues to be overwhelmingly positive. As illustrated in the data, it is quite evident that the parents and carer data reflects in a similar manner to the student and staff data. We received over 100 responses which provided us with the necessary quantity to prove validity. This allows us to consider this data into our school improvement process and inform our directions into the future. I would like to thank all parents that had an opportunity to have their say! On top of these indicators you were surveyed on topics for the school including; Shared Values, Academic Emphasis, Relationships, Parental Involvement at home and school and School and Family Connections.

All of these areas and outcomes in the table are above the A.C.T mean compared to all other primary schools which has been the continued pattern for Charles Conder over the last four years. This is great news and we will stay the course to strengthen these areas into next year. I will be working with the School Board to reflect on elements of this data set to look at ways we can improve.
